We are so very excited to have the opportunity to bless some very special orphans in Tanzania with "Adoptive Father."

As you know, Tanie and I are missionaries to missionaries, which means we are dedicated to encouraging, caring for, and ministering to missionaries who have left home and all that is familiar in order to give their lives to serve others in the Name of Jesus Christ. One such missionary, Claire, is a young woman who has responded to God's call to establish a home and school for albino orphans in Tanzania.

Presently, Claire is caring for 80 orphans, and the number grows daily. As with most orphans, these precious ones face significant physical, mental, emotional and spiritual challenges. However, there is a unique danger that targets albino children particularly —human sacrifice. Albinos are considered to be good luck, so they are sought by kidnappers, sold at high prices, and turned over to witch doctors who carry out the brutal ritual.

Despite a move earlier this year to ban this atrocity, the practice continues. In fact, our missionary informed us that since this is election year, it is especially dangerous, as candidates are known to seek albino "charms" to secure their positions.

Even without this threat, these orphans need to know and experience their Heavenly Father's immense love, to know how much He wants them to belong to His family. This is the very work that Claire is giving her life to. We believe "Adoptive Father" expresses Father's love beautifully, and it is perfectly suited to partner with Claire's message that Father God sees them as wonderfully precious just as they are, and He desires to be their Father.

Thank you so very much, Kayleen, for making it possible for us to support Claire's ministry in Tanzania. We are certain the Kingdom will soon be expanding as these young princes and princesses respond to Father God's invitation.
